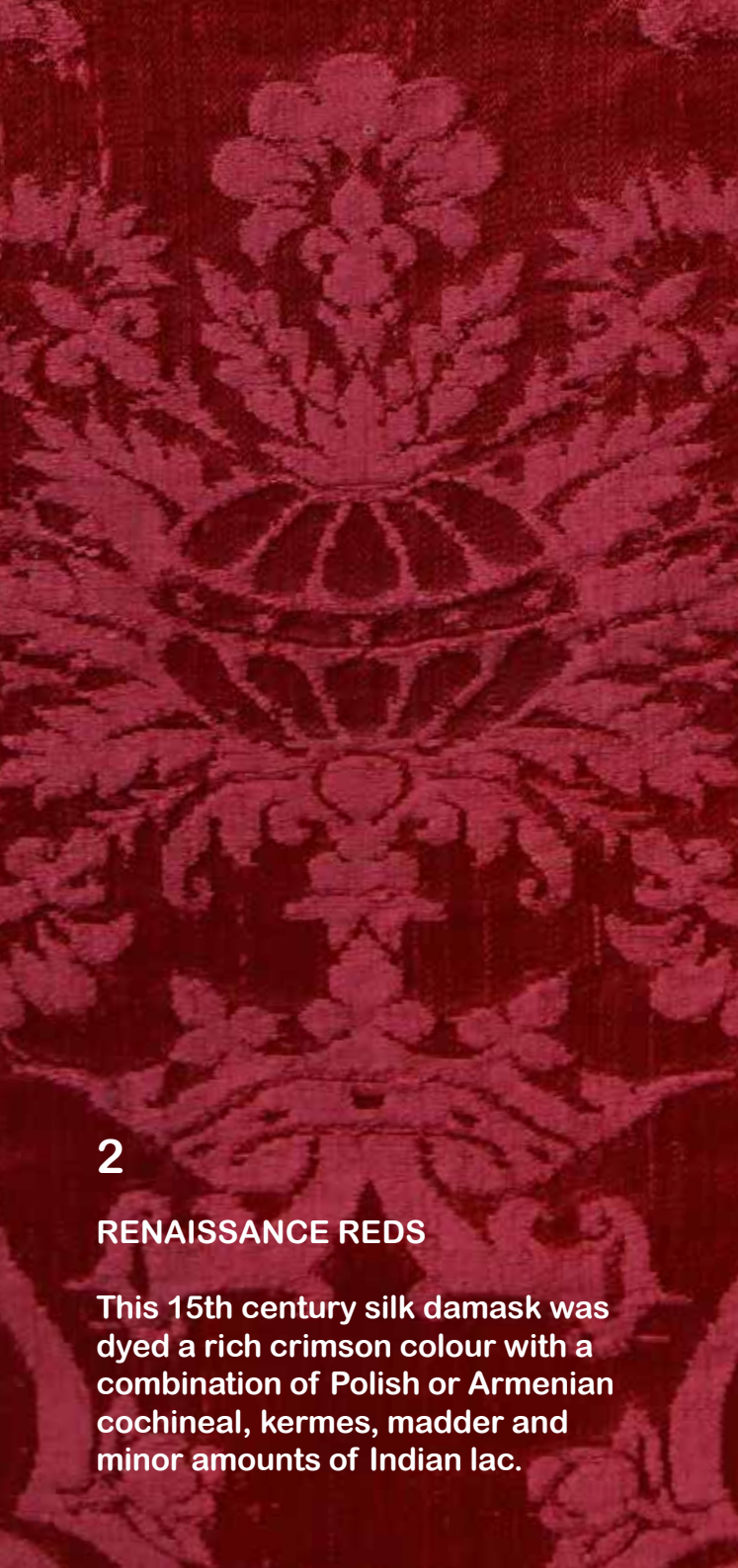

RENAISSANCE REDS

This 15th century silk damask was dyed a rich crimson colour with a combination of Polish or Armenian cochineal, kermes, madder and minor amounts of Indian lac.

RENAISSANCE RELICS

A group of 17th century catholic vestments comprising a cope, a dalmatic and a chasuble have large motifs of roses woven in crimson silk on a white silk background.

RENAISSANCE REINCARNATIONS

A fragment of silk cut velvet c.1600 stamped with a design of strapwork using a technique simple to reproduce on silk velvet or satin for modern interpretations today.
